2015 Teen Pregnancy & Prevention Partnership (TPPP) Training Calendar

TPPP holds **Bi-monthly Professional Development Meetings** the 2nd Friday of every other month from 9-11 at Vision for Children at Risk at 2433 N Grand in St. Louis. These are free to 2015 members and \$10 at the door for nonmembers. NO advanced registration required.

National Sexuality Education Standards (NSES) Trainings are offered for a **Sexual Health Educator certificate**. These seven trainings are \$35 each for 2015 members and \$60 each for nonmembers. Advanced registration is required.

Sexual Health 101 is held annually in the fall for adults new to the field or those in need of an update on contraception, STDs, LGBT issues, techniques for teaching teens, and handling parents' concerns. It is \$50 for 2015 members and \$75 for nonmembers. Advanced registration is required.

TPPP's **Annual Conference, Complete Information – Better Choices**, is held each spring with National Keynote speakers and experts from around Missouri who present on topics related to adolescent sexual health. Conference fees are \$75 for 2015 members, \$100 for nonmembers, and \$35 for students. Advanced registration is required.
